98% of a

of consultants and 92% of cotton growers are now aware of Cottoninfo Connected **14,000** participants (cotton growers and consultants) with over 990 **extension activities**



95% of consultants and 88% of growers think CottonInfo has assisted with **practice change** in key areas



Of 126 events where intention to change was evaluated, **1600** growers indicated they would **change practices** as a result of increased awareness or knowledge
