

The <u>GrazingFutures project</u> has produced yet another case study, documenting the positive impact of practice change, this time with Russell and Donna Lethbridge on "Werrington Station". Changes in management practices over the years has allowed the Lethbridge's grazing business to have relatively mitigated the risk of climate variability while decreasing the breeder mortality rate from 5% to 0.5%.
